

PLAYCRAFTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Playcrafters is committed to producing quality theatre where people can work together with safety, respect, dignity, and freedom from abuse. Playcrafters does not tolerate discrimination, bullying, or sexual harassment of anyone or by anyone involved in Playcrafters activities. This policy applies to all volunteers in whatever capacity they are involved.

- Please honor the commitments that you have made to this theatre and be on time. Call or text the appropriate personnel, if you can't be.
- Be respectful of the Board of Directors, the hierarchy within each production, and other volunteers of this theatre.
 - Use people's preferred names (or character names) or pronouns.
 - Don't take or share photos that someone doesn't want you to take or share
 - Threatening, bullying, and shaming have absolutely no place at Playcrafters. This includes interaction beyond the theater property including online.
 - If in doubt, don't do it. If someone pulls away or asks you to stop it – STOP IT.
 - Alcohol and illegal drugs are NEVER to be consumed/taken prior to or during any performance, rehearsal, build, or strike by any person involved in the show or strike.
- Be respectful of the theatre building, costumes, props, and other assets.
 - This is a non-smoking building. Smoke/vape outside only.
 - Please help keep the theatre's appearance clean and professional. Pick up and clean up after yourself. Discard trash and recycling in appropriate receptacles before leaving the premises.
 - Firearms of any type are not allowed anywhere on the premises other than as necessary in the context of the production.
- Be respectful of the Playcrafters organization.
 - You represent the theater to patrons and the public.
 - Please keep a professional image in the parking lot, lobby, and house.

Anyone who has any questions about these rules, or concerns about the actions of anyone involved, should address them to the Director, Producer, and/or Board Advisor, as may be appropriate under the circumstances. Repeated or serious violations may be escalated to the Board. Any participant who violates this code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from an existing production they are participating in and/or probation or barring from future involvement at Playcrafters.
